## Nursery Learning Highlights

This week in Nursery, the children have been busy designing and building their own robots using magnetic parts. They have shown wonderful imagination as they carefully selected pieces for different purposes, talking about why they chose certain parts and what functions they thought they might have. As they adapted and improved their creations, the children developed their problem-solving skills and learned how to reflect on their work. Through hands-on exploration, they have also been discovering how magnets work and which surfaces they stick to. This engaging activity has supported their fine motor development as well as their communication skills, as they shared ideas and explained their thinking to their friends and teachers



## Reception Learning Highlights

In Reception we have had a great week learning all about how to use our fine motor skills to make spiral and slithering snakes. The children wrote instructions for their friends and their favourite reptile facts. In Maths we have been talking about measuring length and height.




## Lower Key Stage Two Learning Highlights

# Pennoweth World Book Day




Friday 6th March
